Dear Friends, Dear Confreres,

It is my pleasure to invite you to the 41st Grand Chapitre and induction ceremony of the Bailliage de Koweit. The festivities will take place from Friday December 8th, 2023, until Sunday December 10th, 2023, at the newly opened Grand Hyatt Kuwait.

Kuwait is a sovereign state located at the head of the Arabian Gulf. In 1613, Kuwait City was founded as a fishing village predominantly populated by fishermen, and administratively it was a "sheikhdom". By the eighteenth-century, Kuwait was a prosperous maritime port city, the most important in the northern gulf region.

Between 1946 and 1982, Kuwait experienced a period of prosperity driven by oil, and in 1952 it became the largest oil exporter. In June 1961, Kuwait terminated its status as a British Protectorate and became an independent state. Sheikh Abdulla Al-Salem Al-Sabah became Amir under the terms of the newly drafted constitution, and Kuwait held its first parliamentary elections in 1963, making it the first state in the Gulf Council countries to establish a Constitution and a Parliament.

In the 1960s and 1970s, Kuwait was the most developed country in the region and diversified its revenue away from oil exports. It established the Kuwait Investment Authority as the world's first Sovereign Wealth Fund.

In the following pages you will find our Grand Chapitre's celebration agenda as well as information on hotel accommodation. For the convenience of our international guests, we have included some practical information. 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The Chaine des Rotisseurs in Kuwait was founded on April 25, 1982.

The inaugural dinner was at the Hilton International Hotel in Bneid Al-Gar (now closed). This was on the initiative of the Hilton Group, which was planning to establish chapters of the Chaine throughout the Gulf Region.

The late Jean Valby, President of the Chaine des Rotisseurs, officiated this first dinner, in the presence of members of the diplomatic corps, hotel managers and local dignitaries. Twenty-five members were inducted; the late Mr. Choei Mutoh, an esteemed businessman and owner of Kei Japanese restaurant was the first Bailli Delegue of Kuwait (1982-1984).



360 MALL



360 Mall is a shopping mall located on the Sixth Ring Highway in the South Surra, Kuwait that opened on 5 July 2009. The mall has a circular design, and its name 360 is derived from the circular design of the complex, and its design follows the modern architectural design of the exterior and interior.

The mall covers an area of 82,000 m2 (880,000 sq ft) and consists of three floors and three floors of offices. It contains 15 halls of Cinescape cinemas, featuring an IMAX hall and a VIP hall. It contains many restaurants and shops, and the number of 130 registered trademarks. Rafa Nadal Academy Kuwait. Sheikh Jaber Al-Abdullah Al-Jaber Al-Sabah international Tennis Complex also located inside the mall.

In February 2020, the mall opened a new extension connected to the original mall via a climate-controlled bridge with additional retail stores, a food hall and the Rafa Nadal Tennis Academy. 

AMRICANI CULTURAL CENTRE



This is the Amricani Cultural Centre (ACC). The Amricani was built by the Dutch Reformed Church of America in the early 20th century as a hospital. The local people called it "Mustashfaa Amricani". Out of respect for the history of the place, it retained the name "Amricani".

Dar al-Athar al-Islamiyyah (DAI), one of the most important and respected private collections of art from the Islamic lands spanning from Spain to China. It been on loan to the State of Kuwait since 1983. Currently on exhibition at ACC is 'Al-Fann: Art from the Islamic Civilization'.

History

The graceful buildings facing the sea in Kuwait City reflect the commitment to community in the country's past and future. From medical buildings to cultural facilities, the buildings that make up the Al Amricani Cultural Centre have served the people of Kuwait since the early 20th century.

The Amricani compound was originally developed in between 1911 and 1913, with a men's hospital, women's dispensary. The original buildings included a men's hospital, women's dispensary and some administrative offices. A women's hospital was added in the 1930s and a new men's hospital was completed in the 1940s. The hospitals were staffed by individuals from the US, Europe and Kuwait.


The American Mission Hospitals, as the Complex was originally known, closed in 1967, when the Kuwait government had established sufficient public hospitals to serve the community. After a period of rehabilitation and renovation, the buildings were re-animated as a cultural centre and museum.

DAR HAMAD RESTAURANT Authentic Kuwaiti Food at 1:00 PM

Dar Hamad is inspired by memories of the Kuwaiti renaissance of the 1960's, and 1970's. The exterior architecture embodies the rebirth of Al Hamad family house that belonged to the golden era of Kuwait's history. The visual appearance represents al-sandoog al-mubayyat, a traditional Kuwaiti chest that exists in every house.

The interior design also reflects the traditional Kuwaiti sandoog, while incorporating a modern atmosphere. Dar Hamad features five unique sections: the Restaurant, Outdoor Terrace, Chai Lobby, Banqueting, & Sandoog Boutique. Each section represents a distinctive aspect of the Kuwaiti culture.

What makes Dar Hamad most special is the creative implementation of the Kuwaiti cuisine. The cookery was carefully shaped to include influences from the Arabian Peninsula, Persia, India, and the Mediterranean, embracing the entirety of a modern Kuwaiti palate. Kuwait's distinctive hospitality is also represented in the food with rich portions being a central guideline in food presentation. Overall, Dar Hamad is the complete package of Kuwaiti cultural influences, contemporary design and exceptional food craftsmanship

SATURDAY - DECEMBER 09, 2023 TAREQ RAJAB MUSEUM OF ISLAMIC CALLIGRAPHY: 10:00 AM - 11:00 AM



Islamic calligraphy was a major passion of Tareq S. Rajab, the museum's co-founder. He spent much of his childhood marveling at his grandfather's collection of handwritten and illuminated manuscripts of the Qur'an. This motivated him to not only practice calligraphy himself, but to start a collection of his own.

In 2007, he prepared his collection for presentation and opened The Tareq Rajab Museum of Islamic Calligraphy. The calligraphy museum, a branch of the Tareq Rajab Museum, is devoted to the display of Islamic calligraphy across a range of mediums for Arabic script including manuscripts, calligraphy and art, decorated ceramics, metalwork, glass and textiles.

Notable objects on display include important works by Yaqut Al-Musta'simi, Sheikh Hamdullah Al-Amasi, Hafiz Osman and Abdullah Sayrafi, a collection of work by Chinese calligraphers, a number of holy coverings including four Burqa's (curtains of the Holy Ka'aba's door) located at the center of the museum and a curtain from the inside of the shrine of the Prophet Muhammed (PBUH).

AL HASHEMI II, A MAJESTIC WOODEN SHIP


At Radisson Blu Hotel




